Every slab is online Our digital slab gallery lists every natural stone slab in stock — granite, marble, quartzite, soapstone, limestone and more.	Actual-slab images Each slab is photographed individually. What you see is the actual slab: a true-scale, render-ready HD image with its own slab number and dimensions.	
Simple account setup An email address and password are all that is required.	Wishlists Add items and notes to a wishlist, download it as a PDF, and share it with your fabricator.	
Design-ready images Account holders can download HD images and share them with a designer to visualize the stone in the space before requesting a quotation.	Quotations through your fabricator Your fabricator can open the same slabs in their own Hilltop account — dimensions, availability, and the details needed to quote promptly.	
DXF files (coming soon) A DXF file for every slab, so fabricators can plan cuts precisely from the actual slab.

Walk-in registration

Please register at hilltops-surfaces.com before visiting. You will receive our safety guidelines for the warehouse in advance.

Slabs are sold in sequence

A block is cut into consecutive slabs, and we keep and sell them in that order. This preserves vein continuity for your project and for the next customer's.

Technical details on every label

Performance ratings, suitable applications, and care guidance are printed on the slab label.

Organized inventory

Slabs are stored by block and bundle. Each slab carries its own label with slab number, dimensions, and a QR code.

QR code on every slab

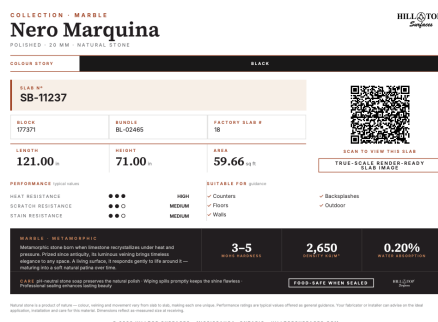
Scanning the label opens the same true-scale HD image available online, ready to share with your designer.

Natural variation

Colour, veining, and movement vary from slab to slab. This is why each slab is photographed individually.

Assistance on the floor

Slabs are stored in bundles, so the front slab of each bundle is visible in person. Our sales team, equipped with iPads, can show you every slab within the bundle in full HD from where you stand and help you shortlist. Your fabricator takes it from there.



The slab label

Each slab carries its own label, and the same label ships with the slab to your fabricator.

- Slab number, block, bundle, and as-measured dimensions
- QR code to the true-scale, render-ready image
- Performance ratings and suitable applications
- Material facts and care guidance

3. After your visit

Ordering and delivery

Ordering

Hilltop supplies through fabricators, designers, and architects. Your fabricator places the order and handles fabrication and installation.

The exact slab you selected

The slab number you chose is the slab that ships to your fabricator.

Labels ship with the slab

Your fabricator receives the slab with its label attached — one scan for the HD image and full specifications. DXF files to follow.
